- A completed Participant Release Form

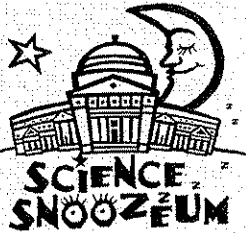
At Check-In:

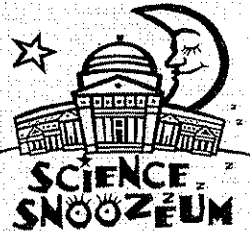
